

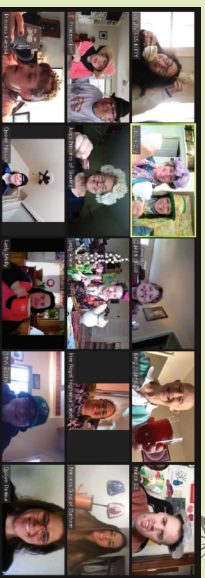
Stay at Home Tea
